Dear Parent,

We're excited to welcome your child to Little Discoverers! We have an adventure-filled summer planned, with activities that support social, creative, and motor development.

Camp Schedule & Logistics:

On the first day, please look for our leaders (**they'll be wearing pink shirts**) who will guide your child to the right room.

Camp starts promptly at **9:30 a.m.**, and early drop-off is not permitted as our staff will be preparing for the day. Pick-up is at **12:30 p.m.**, and your child must be signed out by their leader.

Your child's leader will have a work-issued cell phone, and the number will be provided on the first day of camp. If you can't reach the leader, please contact the Recreation Center at **215-357-5396**, and we will pass along your message.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures:

Please park in the designated spaces near the bus circle off Old Jordan Road and walk your child to **Door C5** for drop-off.

If your child has a sibling attending Camp Explore, both children may be dropped off together at Little Discoverers. Camp staff will escort Camp Explore campers to their program.

At the end of the day, Camp Explore campers who have a sibling in Little Discoverers will be brought to the Little Discoverers location for a single, convenient pick-up.

Please Note: In accordance with district policy and for the safety of all campers, parents and guardians are **not permitted inside the building at any time.**

Thank you for helping us keep the arrival and dismissal process safe and efficient!

Picture Day:

Mark your calendars for **Thursday, July 16!** Each camper will receive a camp T-shirt to wear for Picture Day, Special Event days, or whenever they'd like! Picture order forms and payments must be submitted on Picture Day.

Important Reminders:

- Children must be completely potty trained and self sufficient
- If someone other than you will be picking up your child, please send a signed note with their name and pick-up time.
- For any custody or safety concerns, let us know in advance so we can take necessary precautions.
- We will provide snacks daily. If your child has food allergies or dietary restrictions, please notify us in advance. Please refrain from sending additional snacks unless necessary for specific dietary needs.
- Dress your child in comfortable, play-friendly clothes and **sneakers** (no Crocs or sandals, please). Sneakers are required for all physical activities.
- Please apply sunscreen to your child before coming to camp.
- Please send your child in with a water bottle with their name on it.

Communication:

We will no longer be using Procare for camp communication this summer. After reviewing how the platform was used last year, we have decided not to utilize Procare for camp this season.

Each camp will have a dedicated camp cell phone. Camp leaders will be available by phone or text throughout the camp day, as well as 15 minutes before camp begins and 15 minutes after camp ends. Camp cell phone numbers will be provided to families prior to the start of camp. You may also continue to contact the Recreation Center at 215-357-5396 or the Parks and Recreation Department at 215-357-6800, if you need assistance.

Camp alerts and important updates will be sent through MyRec via email and text message. Please log in to your MyRec account to ensure your email address is up to date and that you are signed up to receive mobile notifications.

We will continue taking photos throughout the summer and sharing them on our social media pages. Be sure to follow Northampton Township Parks & Recreation on Facebook and Instagram to see camp highlights and updates throughout the season.

A Note on Goodbyes:

Some children may feel a little nervous during the first few days. A quick kiss and a cheerful goodbye usually help ease the transition. If we have any concerns, we'll contact you immediately.

We can't wait for a fun-filled summer and to share this experience with your child! Your child's leader will be there to make sure they have a wonderful time.
