



Camp Carnival Day

PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE NEWSLETTER CAREFULLY!

Dear Parents,

Thursday, July 23, 2026, will be Northampton Township Parks and Recreation's Annual Camp Carnival Day! This special day will be held at the Maier Tract Complex (Civic Center II) located at 475 Newtown-Richboro Road. Please find your child's campsite below for specific instructions.

CAMP EXPLORE: Campers should report to Rolling Hills at **8:30 AM**. Campers will be bussed to the carnival. After the event, campers will need to be **picked up at the Maier Tract Complex at 1:00 PM**.

CAMP EXPEDITION: Campers should report to Churchville at **8:30 AM**. Children will be bussed to the carnival. Campers will be bussed to the pool from Camp Carnival Day with a **normal pick-up at the pool**.

CAMP ADVENTURE: Campers should report to the Recreation Center by **8:30 AM**. Campers will then walk down the Maier Tract. After the event, campers will return to the Recreation Center for **normal pick up at the Recreation Center**.

***** IF ANY CAMPERS ARRIVE AT THEIR NORMAL CAMP LOCATION AFTER THE DESIGNATED DROP OFF TIME, THE DOORS WILL BE LOCKED AND EVERYONE WILL BE AT THE EVENT. PLEASE DROP THEM OFF DIRECTLY AT THE MAIER TRACT. PLEASE ESCORT YOUR CHILD DOWN TO CARNIVAL DAY AND LOCATE YOUR GREEN SHIRT (Katie or Sam from Explore, Brigid or Emily from Expedition, and Ava or Chris from Adventure) SO THAT THEY ARE AWARE YOUR CHILD HAS ARRIVED. Remember, your child MUST be registered! There will NOT BE CAMP for anyone not attending this event. *****

This year we have a variety of games and attractions. First, your children will be awed and amazed by the many talents of their very own counselors at our **14th Annual NTPR's Got Talent!** Show. There will be special guests judging and they will pick one group to be the ultimate winner of an awesome prize for their campers! After their performances, from 10:15 AM to 12:45 PM, children will be able to walk around and participate in a variety of activities which include: Dunk Tank, (where campers can attempt to dunk their favorite counselors), Karaoke, Carnival Games, Craft Tables, Mini Golf, Gaming Truck, Face Painting, and Various Inflatable Obstacle courses!

For lunch, children will receive a wristband that is good for a hot dog or chicken nuggets, fries, and a drink (water or juice) for lunch. If your child does not like or

cannot eat either of the lunch choices listed, please provide a lunch with his/her name and site (Explore, Expedition, Adventure) clearly marked.

There will also be a snack stand where campers can purchase fries, soft pretzels, chips, popcorn, and ice cream. Food tickets are available **(\$1 a ticket)** to purchase snacks and/or extra lunch servings. **All snacks are CASH ONLY**, so please send your camper with cash (smaller bills preferred!). PLEASE REMEMBER TO HAVE YOUR CHILD WEAR HIS/HER SPECIAL CAMP T-SHIRT. CAMP ADVENTURE (Rec Center) WILL WEAR THEIR RED SHIRT. This event is open to Camp Adventure, Camp Expedition, and Camp Explore participants who previously registered for this special day. **CAMP WILL NOT BE HELD AT ANY LOCATION FOR THOSE CHILDREN NOT REGISTERED.** If you still wish to register your child, please call Recreation Center at 215-357-5396.

We strongly recommend that children bring water bottles to this event (please make sure to identify it with your child's name and site). It is strictly an outdoor event, and campers can get hot. Please discuss the importance of keeping hydrated with your child. We will have water stations to help campers hydrated, too. **DON'T FORGET YOUR SUNSCREEN!!!!**

Since this is an outdoor event, we have to hope the weather cooperates. If the weather is questionable, please check our website (www.northamptonrec.com) and your email for any cancellation information. In the event of rain, campers should report to their regular camp location on the 23rd and this special day will be cancelled and rescheduled for Friday, July 24th. Again, there will be an announcement via email, text blast, and on our website if the event is postponed due to inclement weather. Fingers crossed for good weather!
