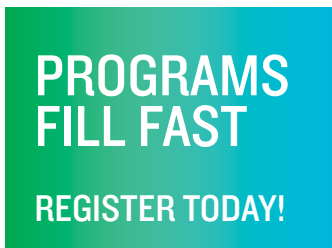

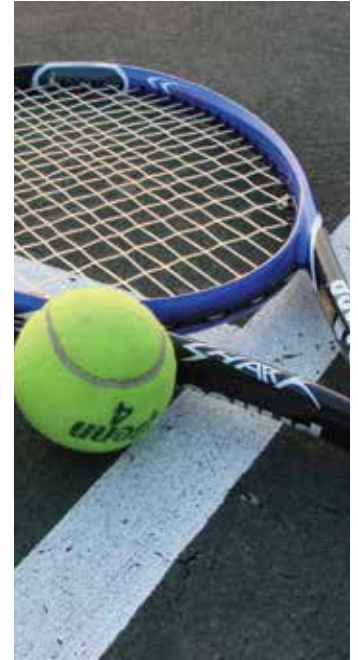

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT TICKS!

### DID YOU KNOW?

- Pennsylvania is #1 in confirmed Lyme disease cases
- Ticks and risk of Lyme exists in every PA county
- When caught early, Lyme can be treated more easily
- Lyme and other tick borne diseases can be serious but also preventable by avoiding high risk tick habitat areas; wearing the proper clothing and repellent; and carefully examining yourself and properly removing ticks, if found.
- A study found people wearing permethrin-treated sneakers and socks were 73.6 times less likely to have a tick bite.

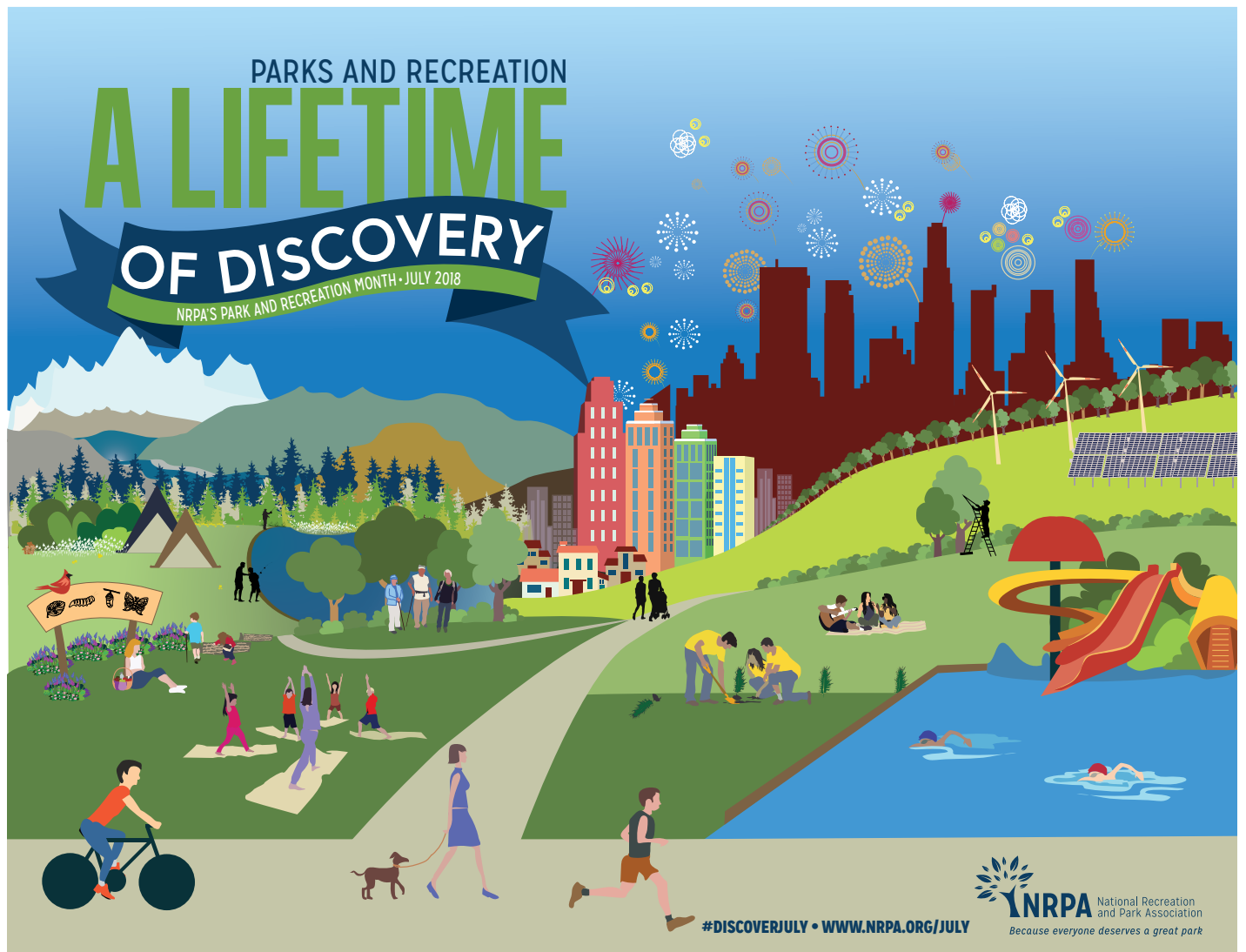
