AG - A -DISTANCE COSTUME PARADE

Northampton Municipal Park, Saturday, Oct. 31 from 11 AM- 1 PM.

This is a FREE event, however **All** children & families **MUST** Pre-Register. Registration will open on Oct. 1, with total number of participants according to PA guidelines at the time. You will receive a designated time to arrive at the Park Hatboro Rd. entrance where you will be lined up at 6 ft. intervals. Contestants will walk an approx. ½ mi. path toward the amphitheater as the judges view each costume. There will be new categories this year with pets now allowed to enter with their family: Most clever costume, best family theme, funniest, best pet duo/ pet family. Check out the categories on the registration form and get your thinking hats on to dazzle the judges. Cash prizes and awards to be given out. Treat bags- wrapped and compiled through Parks & Recreation, will be handed out at the end of the parade for child contestants. And there is more! The walkway will be lined with a variety of scarecrows, for your enjoyment, with a decorated vehicle trunk show at the Maureen M. Welch School-side parking area as part of the parade route. The contestants can cast a ballot for the most creative vehicles. Once your ballot is collected, receive a treat bag provided by P&R, and parade back to your car.

In an effort to keep everyone distanced, participants must adhere to all protocols when registering and follow the organizers directions on the day of. Masks and/or face coverings may be required and need to cover the mouth and nose. Painted faces for costumes will not be permitted unless a mask is also worn by all. Parents/ adults will walk with their children in the parade as a group.
